TASKS OF THE VIII POLISH INTERNATIONAL FLORISTIC CHAMPIONSHIP POZNAŃ 2014

<i>Task 1</i>	
Time	210 min.
Task	Flower arrangement.
Theme	"Floristic travels" - the floristic object inspired by a chosen country.
Description	The object should clearly indicate the country of its inspiration. A short information concerning the choice should be displayed next to the arrangement.
Shape	Optional. The arrangement must not exceed a size of 3.00 x 3.00 m, maximum height is 2,5 m. (It still should be a free space at the stand to display the other compositions).
Technique	At participant`s choice.
Material	Competitors provide all the floristic and construction material according to his/her own conception. Elements of construction have to be set up at the stand just before competition. Floral elements at the construction are not allowed.
Exposition	The task is realized directly at the stand. The proper lighting of the arrangement is provided by participant.

<i>Task 2</i>	
Time	120 min.
Task	Floristic table decoration.
Theme	„Table for the traveler inspired by the culture of the chosen country.
Description	Each participant has to prepare a table decoration expressing the character of the chosen country culture.
Shape	At participants choice. The size of the table together with an arrangement is maximum 1,2 m x 1,2 m, maximum height is 2,5 m. The minimum size and height of an arrangement are not limited. The whole construction and decoration has to allow the consumption of a meal by 2 people. Floral material has to dominate over construction.
Technique	At participant`s choice.
Material	Material is optional. The table and other material is provided by participant according to his/her own conception. Each participant has to set up construction elements just before competition. Floral elements at the construction are not allowed.
Exposition	The task is realized directly at the stand. Each participant provides the proper lighting of his/her arrangement. A short information concerning the choice should be displayed next to the arrangement.

<i>Task 3</i>	
Time	60 min.
Task	Bouquet/decoration for a bride.
Theme	Wedding bouquet/decoration for a bride.
Description	Participant`s own choice.
Shape	Wedding decoration: inspired by the culture of the chosen country. The bride looks forward for a bouquet/wedding decoration referring to the culture of the chosen country. The bouquet or the bride`s decoration has to be arranged so that the bride can hold it or it can be fasten to her arm/hand. The form, design, colours and technique as well as the choice of flowers and other material is up to participant.
Technique	At participant`s choice.
Material	Each participant provides all the material according to his/her own conception. Technical preparation like waxing, wiring, taping etc. of plant material and other elements could be done just before the competition at the time given. Construction elements without plant material could be prepared earlier at the time given.
Exposition	The arrangement is prepared directly at the stand. Each participant should provide a holder or a platform to exhibit the bouquet/decoration. The holder is not judged. A drawing or a picture of an appropriate wedding dress should be placed next to the bouquet.

<i>Task 4</i>	
Time	45 min.

Task	Surprise.
Theme	-
Description	Each participant is given the same set of materials: flowers, greenery and other elements. The subject is known just before the task. There is 10 minutes to “familiarize” with the material. Participants could use all the material given or only a part of it. There is an obligation to use material indicated by organizers. Except “obligatory products”, it is not necessary to use all assortment or the whole quantity of each material.
Technique	At participant`s choice.
Material	Except of material provided by organizers, no other elements are allowed. Participants can use their own tools but glue guns are not permitted.
Exposition	The arrangement is prepared at the place fixed by organizers and it is exhibited at the stand as well.
